- Please check in at the information booth upon arrival!
- Hours of Festival are Saturday and Sunday 9am-4pm.
- There are absolutely no vehicles allowed on the grounds to pack up **BEFORE 4PM** on Sunday. If you are caught with a vehicle on the grounds before that time, you will not be able to participate in future events. **SEE ATTACHED LIABILITY FORM.**
- You may set up on Friday starting at Noon until 6pm and 6am to 8:30am on Saturday & Sunday.
- ALL VEHICLES must be off of the grounds by 8:30AM Saturday and Sunday!
- **If you sell an edible item, you must turn in a certificate of liability with The Greater Lake Placid Chamber of Commerce listed as additional insured.** (A example certificate is available upon request) along with your completed rules sheet, registration form and release of liability form **BEFORE** you set up.
- ALL tents are required to be tied, staked down, or weighted.
- This is a rain or shine event. **NO REFUNDS** unless The Chamber of Commerce cancels this event. All other cancellation refunds will be at the discretion of the Country Fair Committee.

All items must be **HANDCRAFTED** by the vendor. **NO** mass-produced, commercial, used, or resale products shall be sold. **No** buy/sell items. The committee reserves the right to remove any vendor not following the rules.

No commercial vending vehicles, trailers or trucks will be allowed to stay in the park. **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE PARK DURING FAIR HOURS.** Vehicles with trailers must be under 34' in length to enter the park. **NO VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED IN THE PARK AFTER 8:30 AM FOR ANY REASON!** If late setting up, everything must be brought in by hand cart.

Please unload in 20 Minutes. Then set up your display **after** parking in reserved vendor spaces.

****If you sell an edible item, you must also provide a certificate of liability with the Greater Lake Placid Chamber of Commerce named as the first insured before you set up at the festival.**

***All tents will now be required to be tied, staked down, or weighted.** You will receive an acceptance email in January 2025. (If you wish to receive your packet via US postal service instead, please provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with payment.)

Arts & Crafts Country Fair Rules and Requirements Acceptance Form

This page **MUST** be signed separately from the vendor application

Due to multiple vendor violations during the 2025 Caladium Festival – specifically vendors bringing vehicles onto the festival grounds before the festival officially ended, this additional contract is now required.

We understand that at the end of a festival, you are all ready to pack up and get home, but safety **MUST** be our primary obligation.

ABSOLUTE VEHICLE ACCESS RULES:

- **NO vehicles past barricades after the following times:**
 - Saturday & Sunday: 8:30AM
- **NO vehicles onto festival roads or grounds BEFORE the following times:**
 - Saturday & Sunday 4:pm

At the 2026 Arts & Crafts Country Fair, this rule will be strictly enforced by Law Enforcement!

In Florida, moving or driving around a police barricade on a road can have serious legal consequences as you are in violation of lawful order (F.S. 316.072)

Under this statute, it is unlawful to disobey any traffic control device or law enforcement officer's directive.

Penalties: This is usually a second-degree misdemeanor punishable by:

- Up to 60 days in jail
- Up to \$500 fine
- Possible probation

****The consequences are much more serious if it's during a permitted event (Such as the Country Fair!)**

ELECTRICITY

The Arts & Crafts Country Fair does NOT provide ELECTRICITY!

If you need electricity, you must provide it yourself. In the form of a quiet run generator.

By signing below, I understand:

- I will not bring any vehicle past barricades before the permitted times.
- I am legally and financially liable if I violate this rule.
- This rule exists to protect public safety and the future of the Caladium festival.
- Water and Electricity are NOT provided by the Caladium Festival.
