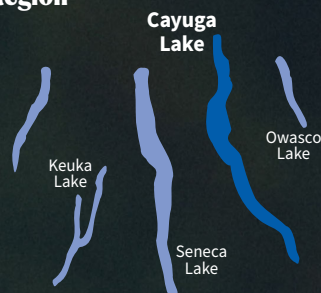
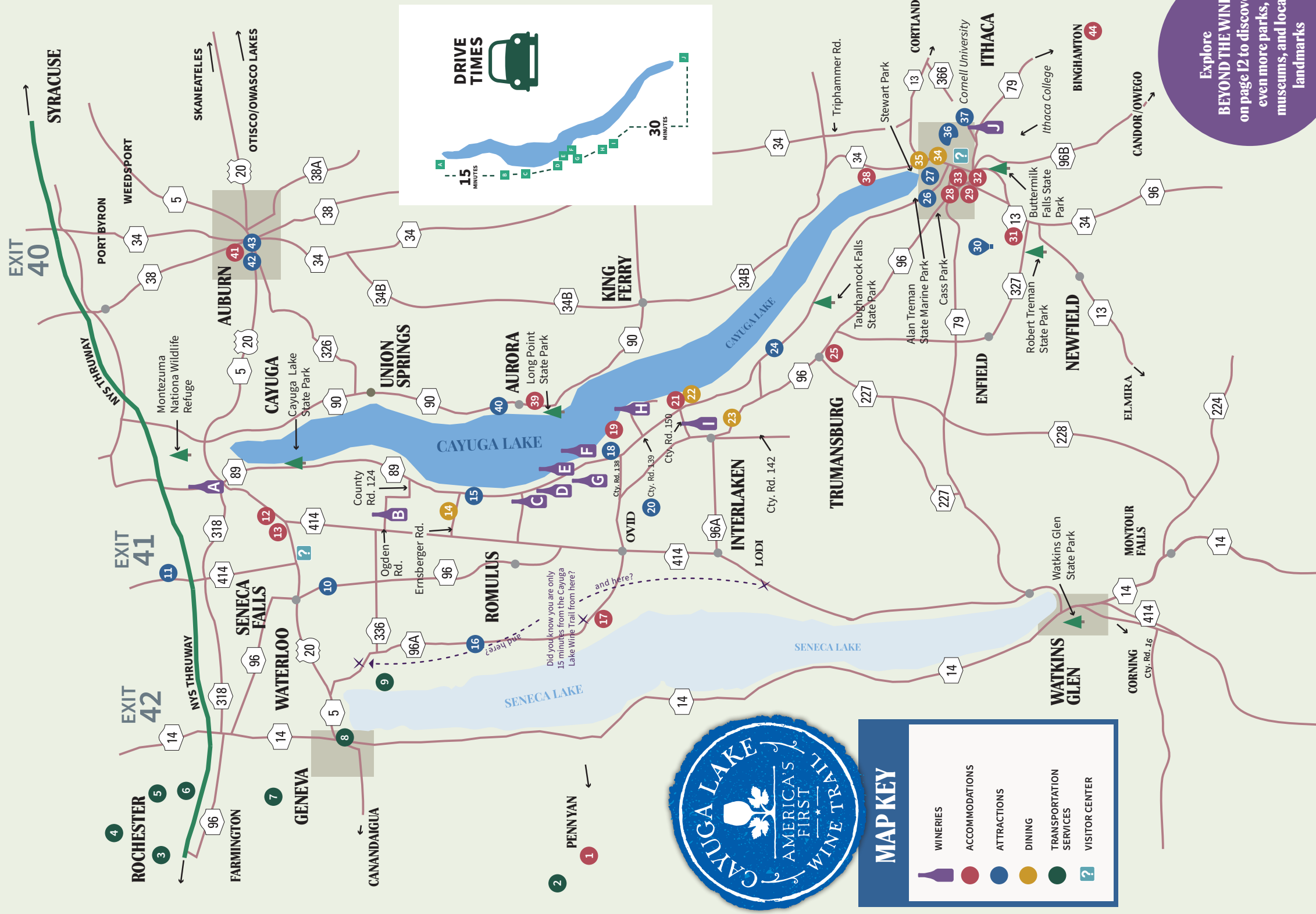

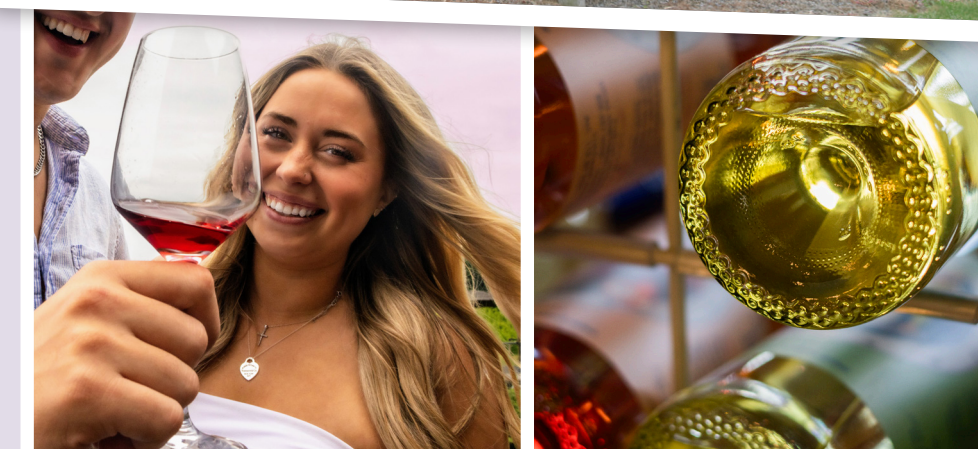

BEYOND THE WINE

The Cayuga Lake Wine Trail is just the beginning of your adventure. Around the lake you'll find breathtaking state parks with towering waterfalls, historic landmarks that shaped our nation, family-friendly museums, outdoor art trails, and plenty of ways to enjoy the natural beauty of the Finger Lakes. Whether you're looking to hike, bike, explore, or simply relax, there's something for everyone to discover beyond the wine.

Waterfall & Gorge State Parks

Taughannock Falls State Park (Cayuga Lake, Trumansburg) – Home to a 215-foot waterfall (taller than Niagara), hiking trails, swimming beach, marina.

Buttermilk Falls State Park (Ithaca) – Multiple cascades, swimming area, and gorge/hiking trails.

Robert H. Treman State Park (Ithaca) – Known for Enfield Glen gorge, Lucifer Falls (115 feet), camping, and swimming.

Watkins Glen State Park (Seneca Lake, Watkins Glen) – The most famous in the region, with a gorge trail that passes 19 waterfalls.

Lakeside & Recreation-Oriented State Parks

Cayuga Lake State Park (Seneca Falls) – Beach, boat launch, camping, and playgrounds.

Long Point State Park – Finger Lakes (Aurora, Cayuga Lake east side) – Small, quiet park with a beach, fishing, and trails.

Allan H. Treman State Marine Park (Ithaca, Cayuga Lake) – Large marina and lake access, great for boating.

Seneca Lake State Park (Geneva) – Swimming beach, large playgrounds, splash pad, picnic areas, and flat walking trails.

Sampson State Park (Romulus, Seneca Lake) – Expansive lakeside park on a former military base with a marina, camping, trails, and a military museum.

County & Municipal Parks

Stewart Park (City of Ithaca) – Lakeside park on Cayuga Lake with playgrounds, walking paths, and events.

Myers Park (Tompkins County, Lansing) – Popular Cayuga Lake swimming and boating spot with picnic areas.

Cass Park (City of Ithaca) – Trails, skating rink, sports fields.

Trails & Greenways

Cayuga-Seneca Canal Trail – Multi-use path linking Cayuga and Seneca Lakes.

Cayuga Lake Blueway Trail – A mapped network of public access points for paddlers to explore Cayuga Lake by kayak, canoe, or paddleboard, showcasing the region's natural beauty and scenic shoreline.

Cayuga Waterfront Trail (Ithaca) – Scenic walking/biking path along Cayuga Lake.

National Historic Parks & Landmarks

Women's Rights National Historical Park (Seneca Falls) – Site of the 1848 Women's Rights Convention; includes Wesleyan Chapel and historic homes.

Harriet Tubman National Historical Park (Auburn) – Preserves Harriet Tubman's home, church, and legacy.

Seward House Museum (Auburn) – Home of William H. Seward, Secretary of State under Lincoln (purchased Alaska).

Elizabeth Cady Stanton House (Seneca Falls) – Part of the Women's Rights NHP, former home of the women's rights leader.

Outdoor Art & Sculpture Trails

Ludovico Sculpture Trail (Seneca Falls) – Sculptures along the Cayuga-Seneca Canal, blending art, nature, and history.

Art Trail in Tompkins County (Ithaca area) – Twice a year "Greater Ithaca Art Trail" open studio weekends + some public outdoor displays.

Cornell Botanic Gardens Sculpture & Garden Walks (Ithaca) – Outdoor art pieces mixed with themed gardens and trails.

Major Art Museums

Cornell Johnson Museum of Art (Ithaca) – Designed by I.M. Pei; strong Asian, African, and contemporary collections.

Schweinfurth Art Center (Auburn) – Contemporary exhibitions, famous for its annual Quilts=Art=Quilts show.

Specialty & Local Interest Museums

It's a Wonderful Life Museum (Seneca Falls) – Small but fun for fans of the movie, often with family events in December.

National Women's Hall of Fame (Seneca Falls) – Honors the achievements of extraordinary American women; features exhibits, artifacts, and inspiring stories in the historic Seneca Knitting Mill.

Ward W. O'Hara Agricultural Museum (Auburn) – Historic farming tools, blacksmith shop, and hands-on exhibits.

Waterloo Memorial Day Museum (Waterloo) – Tells the story of Waterloo as the birthplace of Memorial Day.

Wildlife & Nature Centers

Montezuma National Wildlife Refuge (Seneca Falls) – Major migratory bird stopover; bald eagles, herons, waterfowl, and seasonal nature programs.

Finger Lakes Raptor Center (Trumansburg/Ithaca area) – Focuses on rescue and rehab of hawks, owls, and eagles (special programs, not always open daily).

Cayuga Nature Center (Ithaca) – Live animal exhibits (snakes, owls, turtles), a lodge with nature displays, and outdoor trails with a treehouse.

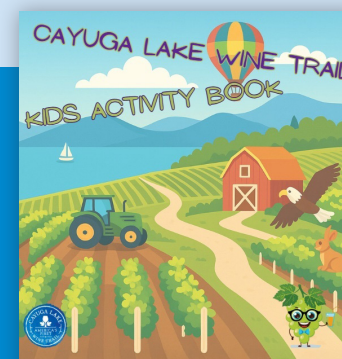
