The Special Meeting of the Town of Cambria Town Board was held at 7:00 pm on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of August 2025, at the Town Hall, 4160 Upper Mountain Road, Town of Cambria, New York.

Following salute to the flag, Deputy Supervisor/Councilman Roberts called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Board members took action upon the following matters:

The clerk reported that 3 letters of interest were received by those wanting to be considered for the Town Supervisor Appointment. One of those people received 4 letters of support. All letters were distributed to the Town Board and Attorney for their review.

**APPOINTMENT OF TOWN SUPERVISOR TO FILL VACANCY**

**Upon a motion duly made by Councilman Roberts and seconded by Councilman Musall, it was resolved to appoint Matthew P. Foe, 4517 Upper Mt. Rd. Lockport, NY 14094 to the vacant seat of Town Supervisor effective 9/1/2025 to 12/31/2026.**

Deputy Supervisor/Councilman Roberts listed Mr. Foes experience to include: serving on the Planning Board, Town Board, Deputy Supervisor, Drainage Committee, Municipal Budget experience, Union Contract Negotiations, Liaison to the Highway Department where he worked with the Superintendent on heavy equipment purchases, member of the Niagara County Task Force on Flooding working with the DEC and the US Army Corp of Engineers, working with the Engineers on the Lead Pipe Project, working with the IDA on proposed Industrial Park on Junction Rd., currently Commissioner of Special Projects for the Town and worked with the Engineers on water and sewer construction.

Councilman Musall also added that he went back and forth through the other two applicants who wanted to be considered. He doesn't think anyone can look past Matt's tenure with the Town and he is the person the Town needs right now.
