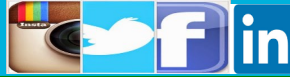

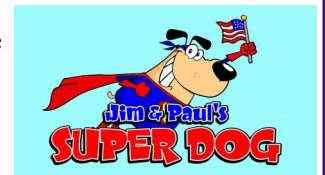

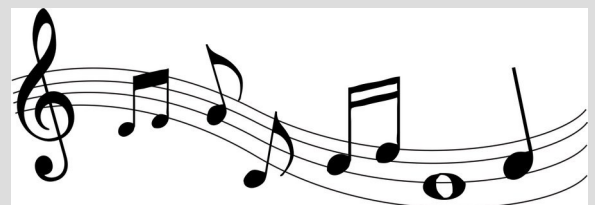
## JOIN US FOR OUR ANNUAL SUMMER CONCERT SERIES ON THE PATIO!

Thank you for your understanding.

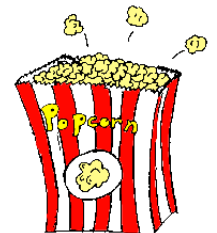
