Revised Care & Maintenance: Texas-Tough Terrain

Universal Rocks RC terrains are engineered with the same professional-grade durability we use for zoo exhibits and commercial landscapes. They are designed to be used, abused, and enjoyed.

- **Cleaning Made Easy:** Due to the ultra-realistic rock texture, we don't recommend wiping with cloths or paper towels as they may snag. Instead, simply shake off loose dirt, use compressed air or a leaf blower, or rinse with a hose.
- **Power Wash Approved:** For a deep clean, these terrains can handle a pressure washer up to 3500 PSI. For best results, keep the nozzle about 4 inches from the surface.
Note: The natural mineral finish is permanently bonded; while you may see "dust" in the first few cleanings, the color will not wash away.
- **Solvent Warning:** Our **Proprietary Technical Shell** is highly resilient to most household cleaners. However, avoid using acetone, paint thinners, or similar strong solvents, as these can impact the finish.
- **Weatherproof & Permeable:** These terrains are 100% UV-stable and "weather-proof" for year-round outdoor use. They will not rot or degrade when wet. Because we mold from real stone, the shell is naturally **permeable**; if cleaning indoors, ensure you have a waterproof barrier underneath to catch drainage.
- **Natural "Shape-Shifting":** If stored in a way that causes the terrain to bow, don't sweat it—this can actually create unique new "lines" and challenges for your crawler! The shell has a natural memory and will generally return to its original form, especially on warmer days.
- **Unmatched Durability:** This terrain is built to withstand incredible weight and impact. As seen in our testing, you can drive a full-sized vehicle over these and they will return to shape immediately.
- **Resilient Mounting Surface:** Don't be afraid to get creative with your course layout. If you use screws to temporarily secure the terrain into plywood or a wooden frame, the shell's natural elasticity and deep rock texture help conceal the entry points once the hardware is removed. This allows you to reconfigure your course and create new, challenging lines repeatedly without the terrain looking "chewed up."
