1. Literati History:

- 1. Create Literati Style with a problem tree that doesn't fit any other style, BEFORE WE UNDERSTOOD THAT IT WAS AN ACTUAL STYLE
- 2. There are no rules, anything goes, NOT TRUE
- 3. Literati Style is comparable to Abstract art, it reapplies the basic rules of Balance and Negative Space to create a subtle and sensitive use of Space and Movement, THIS IS WHAT MAKES IT SO HARD FOR SOME PEOPLE TO UNDERSTAND
- 4. From the art world, understanding Balance, Mass and Negative Space is absolutely necessary to understanding and creating a successful Literati Bonsai

2. Selecting trees for Literati:

- 1. All basic Literati features to work with (better chance for a good or great Literati)
- 2. Difficult tree doesn't fit any other style (better chance for a poor or mediocre Literati), but it is possible to have a good Literati bonsai if you really understand the style, it's just more difficult

3. Different levels of Literati:

1. Literati

- 1. Trunk movement a major element and usually the, Focal Point
- 2. Branches and foliage carefully Balancing trunk movement, Negative Space
- 3. Thin delicate branches to compliment thin delicate trunk, Visual Harmony
- Negative Space created throughout the foliage to lighten the feeling of Mass or Visual Weight

2. Literati Style, (having all the elements listed in #1 and #2)

- 1. Slender trunk
- 2. No branches on the lower 2/3 of the trunk
- 3. Minimal foliage masses
- 4. Subtle to Dramatic Trunk and Branch movement

3. Literati Influence

- 1. Looking
 - 1. More foliage mass then the actual Literati Style
 - 2. Has slender trunk
- 2. Feeling
 - 1. More foliage mass then the actual Literati Style
 - 2. Has heavy trunk
